





Notes About Planning

- Students can plan courses into the future, but those courses may not be offered when planned.
- Students will still need to register for a section of a particular course.
- Some students are still confused that they are not enrolled in "planned" courses.
- Students can add courses to a term, but they can also add a term and plan courses

Retention Review

Cohort Retention (based on registration status)

- FA22 -> SP23 FY Student Retention Rate (349/379): 92.1%
- FA22 -> FA23 FY Student Retention Rate (297/379): 78.4%
- FA22 -> FA23 FY Provisionally Admitted Student Retention Rate (15/25): 60%

Fall 2022: 25 First Year students and 3 Transfer Students

Fall 2023: 38 First Year students and 1 Transfer Student



Provisions of the Provisionally Admitted Students

- Required to attend the Summer Academic Academy, weeklong intensive with the following goals
 - 1. Academic Preparation and Readiness
 - 2. Resource Building
 - 3. Network Building
- Required to take IDST*010 Learning Skills course in fall term
- Must maintain a 2.0 GPA in fall term.




Summer Academic Academy

- 33 Students fully attended the Academy (6 exemptions)
- Writing and Communication Sessions led by Maureen Barney
- Math and Quantitative Reasoning Sessions led by Chuck Dunn and Mike Hitchman
- Keys to Success Sessions led by Chase Andrews and Ginny Blackson
- Student Support Sessions
- Social Events



Summer Academic Academy

Student Survey* results, administered at the conclusion of the Academy, indicate that the program was well-received:



IDST*010: Learning Skills

- 5 Sections with 12 seats in each in Fall 2023
- 1-Credit Paracurricular course meeting each week, covering topics such as
 - Time-Management, Study Skills, Growth Mindset, Etc.
- Current enrollment of 62 (plus waitlists), reflects over 20 new incoming students self-selecting into the course
- All Provisionally Admitted Students are currently enrolled

Early Intervention Tools


- STOPLIGHT SURVEY: ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE OF FIRST YEAR STUDENTS AT WEEKS 3 AND 8 OF SEMESTER. SUBMITTED IN CAT COMPASS
- ACADEMIC ALERT: FOR STUDENTS EXPERIENCING ACADEMIC
 CHALLENGES NOT CAPTURED BY THE STOPLIGHT SURVEY. I.E., NON-FIRST
 YEARS, ISSUES AT VARIOUS WEEKS DURING THE SEMESTER, ETC.
 SUBMITTED IN ETRIEVE
- CARE REFERRALS: CONCERNS ABOUT A STUDENT'S WELLBEING,
 TYPICALLY OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM. SUBMITTED IN CAT COMPASS



Stoplight Survey: First-Year Student Intervention

RAPID CHECK IN ABOUT HOW STUDENTS ARE DOING AT WEEKS 3 (SEPT. 11-17) AND 8 (OCT. 16-22)

- RED- NOT ATTENDING OR COMPLETELY DISCONNECTED FROM CLASS
- YELLOW- SHOWING SIGNS OF DIFFICULTY OR MAY BENEFIT FROM ADDITIONAL RESOURCES
- GREEN- DOING FINE






Academic Alerts


- USED AS AN EARLY REPORTING SYSTEM FOR STUDENTS HAVING ACADEMIC RELATED ISSUES
- PROCESSED BY ACADEMIC ADVISING BUT NOT RESOLVED BY ACADEMIC ADVISING
- CONNECTS STUDENT WITH THEIR FACULTY ADVISOR AND OTHER RESOURCES SUCH AS LEARNING SUPPORT SERVICES (LSS)

Five-year partnership with Credo, to increase our retention rate from 81% to 86% over five years.

Academic Advising Success Initiative Team

- 1. Major Accomplishments in year one:
 - Review of Advising Structures at Linfield
 - Communication Plan around the Advising points of contact for students
 - Gathering of strategic student information to inform advising process
- 2. Tasks and projects heading into fall 2023
 - Establish a permanent Advising Committee appropriately placed within the governance structure
 - Use data to better understand major selection and interests
