## Requirements for Entry to the School of Nursing:

- C or better in each prerequisite course (except INQS 125) at the time of application and transfer. If a student has already taken a prerequisite course and has a C or better, they must submit that grade on the application. Graded prerequisite courses with a C or better will be counted in the GPA calculation unless the student is registered to repeat a course. In this case, verification of registration for the repeat is required (screenshot or photocopy showing registration for course, term and student's name is acceptable).
- 3.0 GPA in the prerequisite coursework at the time of application AND at the time of transfer.
- 3.0 GPA in Science courses (Biology/Chemistry, Anatomy, Physiology, \& Microbiology) at the time of application AND at the time of transfer.
- Minimum Anatomy \& Physiology GPA 2.67 at the time of application AND at the time of transfer. Students may attempt each course in the Anatomy \& Physiology sequence no more than twice each. In the case where a student has more than one repeat of a course, only the grade from the first repeat will be used in the GPA calculation. Withdraws count as an attempt). If a student withdrew from one of these courses for reasons other than poor academic performance, the student may consult with the registrar's office on how to petition for an exception.
- 62 transferable credits completed. Students who intend to complete only nursing major coursework in the School of Nursing will transfer with 71 credits, including all requirements common to all Linfield Bachelor's degrees.
- A minimum of 30 Linfield credits at Linfield must be earned to be considered for priority enrollment.
- Minimum of $\mathbf{1 8}$ semester credits of nursing prerequisites (including a minimum $\mathbf{8}$ semester credits of lab science courses) is required at time of application.
- All Linfield students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above to transfer and graduate.
*Transfer is defined as enrollment in the School of Nursing
