

## **Expectations of Linfield College Fraternity & Sorority Chapter Faculty Advisor**

Each chapter is encouraged to develop a relationship with a member of the Linfield College faculty to provide members of the organization with an opportunity to interact with faculty and to receive assistance in developing a working chapter scholarship program. The primary role of the faculty advisor is to encourage strong academic achievement in the chapter they advise. The faculty advisor position may be expanded by agreement of the chapter and the faculty member to advise other areas of chapter operations based on the interest and the experience of the faculty member; and in instances where the faculty advisor is an alumni member of the chapter they may serve a dual role of alumni and faculty advisor to the chapter if they wish.

The College asks that faculty advisors:

1. Meet regularly with the appropriate executive officer/s of the chapter to provide the officer/s with feedback on issues facing the chapter.
2. Become familiar with Linfield College policies related to fraternities and sororities, which can all be found on the FSL website.
3. Advise the chapter's scholarship chair and encourage positive academic standards within the chapter.
4. Involve the Fraternity & Sorority Life office on issues with which the faculty advisor would like assistance in addressing the needs of the chapter.
5. Review semesterly chapter academic reports with the appropriate executive officer/s.
6. Assist the chapter in developing a policy for supporting members who may be struggling academically.
7. Support the legal and ethical operation of the fraternity or sorority by confronting issues that deserve closer attention by the chapter.
