WNE -211	Introduction To Viticulture						
<p>This seminar course is designed to introduce students to where and how grapes are grown. Emphasis will be given to understanding the types of varieties of grapes, their general biology and physiology, and the environmental factors required to grow grapes including climate, geology, soil, and landscapes. In addition, the course will cover basic aspects of vine growth development and training, trellis systems, and vineyard management. \$60 course fee. 2 credits.</p> <p>This course will be an intensive, 5-day field course in Oregon wine country. Course participants will complete online readings and short assignments on farming and viticulture in anticipation of field trips on the course dates. Students should come prepared for outdoor weather, including sturdy walking shoes or boots, hats, sunscreen, and water bottles. Lunch will be provided by the Linfield College. Transportation will be provided, departing from Linfield College each day. Course field trip dates in McMinnville, Oregon: August 18-22. Course Instructor: Jeff D.
