SUPPORT SERVICES ONLY

"I don't want any further action to be taken. I just need support services."

There are some situations where the school is required to move forward a report such as an instance of child abuse or danger to campus safety.



SUPPORT & INVESTIGATION

"I've decided that I want the school to investigate what happened."

Depending on the conduct, we will proceed with either federal Title IX policies, or Linfield's Sexual Harassment and Relationship Violence policies.

FEDERAL TITLE IX POLICY

Written report of what happened created.

Title IX Coordinator explains which policy applies to the report.

SEXUAL MISCONDUCT & RELATIONSHIP VIOLENCE POLICY

INVESTIGATION

Provide information and evidence to investigator. Other party gets a copy of all evidence as well.

If needed, safety measures such as no-contact orders put into place.

INVESTIGATION

Provide information and evidence to investigator.

HEARING

Hearing (including cross examination) in which an external person decides whether violation occurred.

SUBSTANCE CLEMENCY

Students will not be disciplined for the University's drug & alcohol policies that occurred in connection with the disclosed prohibited conduct. *See full policy.
